

In talking with our leadership, we are excited to announce that we will be regathering for in-person worship on Sunday May 31 (both morning and evening).

This Phase 1 of regathering comes after lots of prayer and discussion and as of Tuesday, is in accordance with the Governor's statement regarding inperson worship services.

On our website (underthesteeple.com) and Facebook page you will find more information about the steps we will be taking to keep everyone as safe as possible. Starting now and into next week we will be sending more info and guidelines your way through videos, email, mailouts, etc...that will help walk you through some of the many things that will be different.

For starters, let me go ahead and point out two important ones:

First of all, our Sunday morning worship times will be slightly different—8:00; 9:30; 11am. The reason for this change is to allow ample time to clean our sanctuary after each service. Also, for this first phase we will not have Sunday School or nursery available.

Secondly, please know that while we will be taking every precaution for your safety, we want you to make wise decisions about when you choose to return for live services. Please do not feel pushed to regather if you are hesitant. Pray and make the best decision for you and your family. We do, however, want to encourage all our elderly and anyone with underlying conditions or compromised immune systems to continue worshiping with us from home.
